Frequently Asked Questions

- Why is the festival changing from 4 days to 3 days?
The Festival is being condensed to provide larger National Entertainment over three days
 - What are the Festival Dates
Saturday September 1 11am - 10pm, Sunday September 2 11am - 10pm, and Monday September 3rd 11am - 8pm.
 - How much are food and beverage tickets?
Food and Beverage tickets are available throughout the festival at a cost of 15 tickets for \$10.
 - What type of food will be at the festival?
The festival will feature many local and regional restaurants and food vendors. Please visit the experience section of the festival web site for the full list of food vendors.
 - Can I bring in a backpack?
Bags and backpacks are allowed. Please note all attendees and bags are subject to search and wanding by security staff.
 - Can I bring a baby stroller?
Yes strollers are allowed. Please note all attendees, bags, and strollers are subject to search and wanding by security staff.
 - Do you have a carnival?
We do not have a carnival at the festival. We have added many other new-featured attractions.
 - Will the festival be open if it rains?
Yes, the Festival will be open rain or shine.
 - Can we bring dogs/animals?
Dogs and pets are not allowed at the Festival. Service Animals are the exception to this rule.
 - Can we bring water/food/drink/cooler?
No outside food or beverages of any kind are allowed inside the Festival. Non-alcoholic beverages are allowed only if the bottle is factory sealed. 1-liter bottle limit per person. Glass bottles and containers are not permitted.
 - If I have a concealed Carry Permit can I bring in a firearm?
Absolutely no weapons are allowed inside the Festival. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**
 - Is there somewhere inside we can fill up a water bottle?
Yes. There are water fountains located at Colfax and Broadway, and Colfax and Bannock. However, any water bottles brought into the park must be empty in order to enter the Festival.
 - Where should I park?
There are many public parking lots and garages located around the Festival.
 - Where can we find handicap accessible parking?
There are many public parking lots and garages located around the Festival which have handicap parking.
 - Where should I park my bike?
There are bike racks located at 15th and Colfax near the Webb Building, as well as near 14th Ave. between the Denver Public Library and Denver Art Museum.
 - What is your admission policy?
Admission to the Festival is free, including the concerts; In addition, this year the festival will feature a ticketed VIP experience. Tickets can be purchased on www.axs.com.
 - Do you have lost and found?
